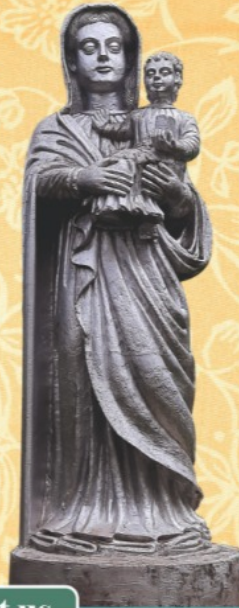

A Brief History

Institute Mater Dei (IMD) was born in 1964 as a response to the renewal of the religious life according to the teaching of the Second Vatican Council. The Institute is governed by the Conference of Religious of India, Women's section (CRWI).

The curriculum of IMD is designed to give students an adequate foundation in philosophy, theology, psychology, spirituality, and religion. The objective is to create in them the ability to reflect on experiences in the light of theological perspectives. Reading the signs of the time the Institute remains open for upgradation.

Religious from several Congregations come together with the same motivation and put together their vision, efforts, talents and thus benefit from one another for an integral growth, besides benefiting from multicultural contribution. The holistic formation training programme offered by the Institute motivates the young consecrated religious to be deeply rooted in faith, reason and mission. Sisters professed temporarily are given individual guidance to be committed in their vocation and to grow in the love of Jesus. The institute provides opportunities for spiritual growth, assimilation and updating of Religious Life.

The Crest



The lotus symbolizes integrity, perfection, purity and grace. As an unrivalled symbol of creation, the lotus signifies also spiritual growth and the divine within each person. Rooted in mire, it rises above the surface to bloom with remarkable beauty. From a slender bud, the flower unfolds to reveal delicate petals held together by a strong centre. This represents the aspiration of several women religious congregations with diverse charisms, to come together with a shared vision of the Reign of God for a common mission of compassionate love in action.

The two lotus leaves symbolize harmony and peace. Lotus leaves have amazing curative properties. The two leaves in the symbol signify the caring and healing mission of women as peacemakers to create harmony and wholeness in our world.

M stands for Mary, the Mother of God, who bloomed to her full stature with the grace of God. She is the model for women to grow in the fullness of Christ through human, spiritual, and theological formation.

X and **P** signify the first two letters of Christ in Greek – *X Chi* and *P Rho* - which represent the centrality of Jesus Christ in the life of the Institute Mater Dei.
